CERTIFICATE IN OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY (NQF LEVEL 4)

PURPOSE:

The Occupational Health and Safety programme is based on a real work experiential learning, where students have the opportunity to be attached to different industries to do hazard identification and risk assessments.

The programme has been designed to promote the wellbeing of workers in their respective workplaces, which will yield valuable results such as, improving employee morale, reducing absenteeism, increasing productivity as well as cutting costs arising from occupational injuries and compensations

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Grade 12 with a minimum of 18 points in six subjects with at least an E symbol in English
- A recognized qualification at NQF level 3 or equivalent
- **Mature age entry:**
 - 25 years old or over in the year in which admission is sought
 - At least 2 years of working experience
 - Passed Grade 10



CERTIFICATE IN HEALTH CARE ADMINISTRATION (NQF LEVEL 4)

PURPOSE:

With growth in the diversity of the healthcare system, health care administrators are needed in many settings including clinics, health insurance organizations, hospitals, public health departments, universities, colleges and research institutions. They are commonly responsible for health administration and patient service.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Grade 12 with a minimum of 18 points in six subjects with at least an E symbol in English
- A recognized qualification at NQF level 3 or equivalent
- **Mature age entry:**
 - *25 years old or over in the year in which admission is sought*
 - *At least 2 years of working experience*
 - *Passed Grade 10*



CERTIFICATE IN DENTAL ASSISTANT (NQF LEVEL 4)

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this qualification is to supply the dental profession with competent dental assistants who will be handing tools to the dentist during treatment and examination, sterilizing instruments, operating suction devices, processing X-rays and making impressions for dental fixtures. The qualification addresses the need in the dental profession for dental assistants with recognized qualifications and relevant education and training.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Grade 12 with a minimum of 18 points in six subjects with at least an E symbol in English
- A recognized qualification at NQF level 3 or equivalent
- **Mature age entry**
 - *25 years old or over in the year in which admission is sought*
 - *At least 2 years of working experience*
 - *Passed Grade 10*



CERTIFICATE IN COUNSELING (NQF LEVEL 4)

PURPOSE:

This programme has been specifically designed to equip you with introductory knowledge and basic counselling skills, methods of counselling, theories and techniques in counselling.

It will also help you to understand how to help clients resolve personal and interpersonal conflicts, with the focus on setting goals and problem solving. The programme trains students to provide clients with direction, emotional support and assist them to focus on constructive behaviours.
